Application and acceptance process: Applications are accepted on-line (preferred) and by mail from January 1st through April 1st each year along with the non-refundable application fee. All the applications are juried together in mid-April. Acceptance emails or letters are sent out by May 6th, with booth and other fees then due by May 20th. This is not a first to apply, first to be accepted process. If we are not able to fill the show in April or have cancellations, we will consider late applications through September 15th.

Important: All exhibits must be handmade arts and crafts. In order to maintain a diverse and exciting show for our customers, we will limit the number of exhibitors selling similar types of wares. Exhibitors will be categorized and selected based on the description and photographs provided.

To Apply:

- Complete and sign the on-line Exhibitor Application, stating that you reviewed the Exhibitor Rules & Regulations.
- Return the application on-line with non-refundable application fee or by mail with photographs and nonrefundable application fee payable to "Chapel Hill Arts & Crafts Show". See address below.
- Booth fees and other applicable fees will be collected after notification of your acceptance. All fees are due by May 20. The application fee is in addition to the booth fees. Booth fees sent at the time of application will have to be returned.

- Photographs: You must submit at least 3 photos of your wares and 2 photos of your display. They should include all crafts you plan to sell at the show. If you display items not included in these photos on the day of the show, you could be asked to remove them from your booth unless you have received prior permission from us to include them. Computer printed photos are acceptable if the quality is good. Remember, we only have your photos to represent your work so be sure they are good ones.
- We also ask that you have work-in-progress photos available to show us the day(s) of set-up and show, as we continue to jury during the show, checking for quality, and appearance of display and shopper activity.

NOTE: *We want to maintain the integrity of the show by displaying only **Handmade Arts and Crafts**. If the photos submitted do not demonstrate this guideline, or are absent, you will be notified. You may re-submit your application for consideration with the correct information requested before April 1st.*
